The <i>New Creation</i>	The <i>Old Man</i>
The Soul (mind and emotions) The Battlefield	
Our physical body : love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control	

The <i>New Creation</i>	The <i>Old Man</i>
The Soul (mind and emotions) The Battlefield	
Our physical body : anger, pride, fear boasting, malice, gossip, lies, deceit, hostility, lust, immorality, selfishness, hate, prejudice, etc.

The <i>New Creation</i>	The <i>Old Man</i>

The Soul (mind and emotions) The Battlefield	
Our physical body : Like Doctor Jekyll and Mr. Hyde. One moment loving and kind and the next selfish and self-serving
